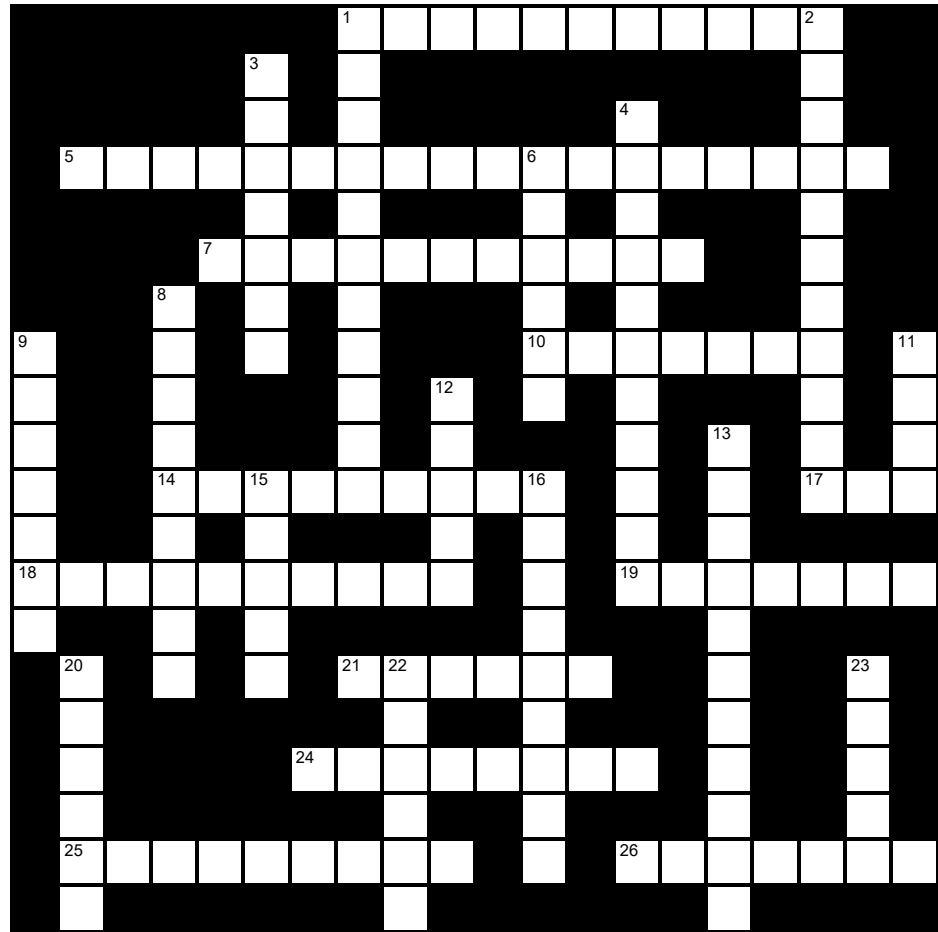


**Meeting Jesus in the Sacraments Chapter 1**

- 5 This sacrament strengthens the sick and suffering members of the Church (9,2,3,4)
- 7 The act by which the Father sent his Son into the world and by the power of the Holy Spirit came to exist as a man within the womb of Mary (11)
- 10 The way Christ dispenses the fruits of the Paschal Mystery until he comes again is the sacramental \_\_\_\_ (7)
- 14 He described sacraments as “visible signs of invisible grace” (9)
- 17 Jesus never ceased to be \_\_\_\_ when he became man (3)
