3. Find the five saints who are quoted in the *Catechism* whose first or last name begin with the letter A. (St. Ambrose, St. Anselm of Canterbury, St. Augustine, St. Thomas Aquinas, St. Athanasius)
4. What paragraph number list the fruits of the Holy Spirit? (CCC, 1832)
5. Which two people are listed as models of faith in the *Catechism*? Abraham (CCC, 145-147) and Mary (CCC, 148-149)
6. What page contains the texts for the Apostles' Creed and Nicene Creed? (varies by edition)
7. On what page can we find the Ten Commandments? (varies by edition)
8. List five councils quoted in the footnotes of the *Catechism*:
